CIRCULAR

Sub: Subsidy by SRU for the conduct of UG/ PG/ Superspeciality students' dissertations/ Research projects - Guidelines - Issued.

Our Chancellor, Sri Ramachandra University is pleased to provide subsidy on the charging pattern of the investigations connected with the Dissertations/ Research projects that are being conducted by UG/PG/Superspeciality Students of all faculties on SRU in partial fulfillment of the requirement for completion of their UG/PG/Superspeciality degrees, in order to promote high quality/publishable Dissertations/ Projects.

The Post-Graduate student carrying out the research project/dissertation should send a request to Pro-Chancellor(Research), Central Research Facility, Sri Ramachandra University, providing the title of the Research Project/ Dissertation, number of patients or samples to be tested, list of investigations required and where these investigations are to be carried out, through their Supervisors & Head of department to Pro-Chancellor (Research). The office of Pro-Chancellor (Research) shall provide a computerized code number, with which the student shall become eligible for the concessional subsidy for the investigations of the said Dissertation/ Research project.

The concessional subsidy pattern is given as below:

- (i) Only 50% of the approved charges would be levied for the investigations/tests that are covered under
 - (a) Sri Ramachandra Hospital - Outpatient /Inpatient
 - (b) Sri Ramachandra Medical Centre Laboratories & Investigational facilities
 - (c) Those available as chargeable tests at CRF, CEFT, other central facilities and departments of SRU
- (ii) In case of specialized investigations that are to be procured as commercial kits, the respective student shall purchase the kit on their own and provide it to the appropriate laboratory of the above categories. Only 50% of the processing charges as decided by the department / laboratory may have to be paid by such students.

These guidelines will come into effect from 6th January 2012.

Guidelines framed in the meeting of the Deans/Principals/PG Ethics Committee Secretaries and POC Committee held on 29/05/2013 for publication of PG - dissertations/Project works of SRU

- A Dissertations/Project works of PGs approved for the University Examinations of the academic years 2010-2011, 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 will be taken in the first phase for preparation of manuscripts, since ethical clearance of these projects would have been given either at the department/faculty level committee or by University IEC
- B The HOD in consultation with faculty may draw up the list of Indian and Foreign journals in that discipline (preferably indexed journals with impact factor) and select the appropriate journals for submission of the article arising out of the PG dissertation/project based on the nature of the research work
- C The manuscript preparation out of the PG dissertation/project should be as per the guidelines provided by the chosen journal for that article. The manuscripts of such dissertations/projects will be prepared by the candidate and/or the supervisor in the department and send it to POC within a month time (end of June, 2013) for plagiarism screening and approval
- D If the HODs of the departments consider that there are unpublished dissertations/ projects still available belonging to earlier years prior to 2010-2011, they could be brought to the notice of POC for case to case based procedure guidelines including the need for IEC clearance.
- E The Deans/Principals of the faculties of the university may kindly take personal steps to co-ordinate this effort with the HODs/Supervisors and make them to strictly adhere to the timeline specified
